ORIGIN OF THE SALSA MUSIC

Salsa is a musical genre that emerged in the 1960s in New York as an evolution and fusion of Afro-Caribbean rhythms, primarily from Cuba and Puerto Rico. Although the term "salsa" gained

popularity during that period, its musical roots trace back to earlier genres such as son cubano, mambo, guaguancó, and the Puerto Rican plena.
