This workshop addresses clinical-educational approaches with children, based on the theoretical perspective of Subjectivity developed by González Rey. It will present theoretical, epistemological, methodological, and instrumental considerations that enable learning and subjective development in boys and girls through the use of puppets and dramatized play.

Learning Objectives

- Understanding the theoretical and epistemological foundations underlying the clinical-educational approach with boys and girls, based on González Rey's concept of subjectivity.
- Carrying out practical methodological exercises from a constructive-interpretative stance, using puppets and dramatized play as instrumental exemplifications.
