About the Workshop

This workshop will explore and analyze best practices related to supervision in professionals within Psychology as a science and application. It will be guided by the recent guidelines of the American Psychological Association and the ethical standards of our colleges and professional associations in the context of the Americas. It will incorporate a theoretical-practical approach to supervision competencies that facilitate the supervisory relationship, standards of excellence, cultural sensitivity, and diversity, as well as the development of supervisees, the well-being of clients and society, with an emphasis on the interdisciplinary dimensions of our profession.

Learning Objectives

- Analysis of theoretical models and definitions: (1) Analysis of evidence-based practices & (2) Reflection and analysis of ethical and professional dilemmas related to supervision.
- Review of the interdisciplinary approach: (1) Convergence between interventions similar to supervision, (2) Identification of areas of collaboration and applications in health and community settings.
- Critical analysis of multicultural competence: (2) Strengthening the attitude of cultural humility in approaching the challenges of diversity.

• Noel Quintero J. Ph.D. is a professor in the Psy.D. Program at Albizu University, San Juan Campus. He has served as the Director of the Clinical Training Program and as a clinical supervisor. He currently teaches courses in Clinical Supervision, Cognitive Assessment, Human Development, and Positive Psychology. He also collaborates as faculty in the Certification in Supervision offered by Albizu University to licensed psychologists in Puerto Rico and other settings within the Latin American context. In 2005, he was honored with the Psychologist of the Year Award presented by the Puerto Rican Psychological Association.
